Guest speakers

Ms. Kelly Lovelett (AP Biology 718-804-6400 X3300) spoke about:

1. Reagent lab (per 12/17) is available.
2. Living Environment will be held on 6/22 and it will be a in person lab
3. The Physic and Chemistry labs are cancelled for this school year
4. All BTHS students will qualify for Living Environment exams and any courses that require Lab hours.
5. BTHS are still required to complete their virtual lab works.



6. BTHS students will be given P=Pass when completed all labs and a NX if Labs are not completed. The NX will become incomplete if students fail to complete work.

Mr. Newman (Principal) discussed:

1. 70% of Bended Students are back in the building for in person learning with no issue.
2. School closure is made by the Mayor and School Chancellor and not the principal.
3. An email was sent out today that a Covid-19 issue and in person learning will be back to remote on Friday 26 and for 48 hours. Once the clear is given a letter will be sent out on when in person learning will start.
4. SAT/ACT will be held on 2 days (4/13 and 4/27). All students were sent a letter on their assigned day. Students cannot attend another day if they missed their assigned day.
5. Students who are blended/in class for the spring and do not show up for in school learning will be forced to remote learning; unless there is a valid excuse.
6. Every 12 days of learning, students will be given a chance to catch up on missing work.
7. There are office/tutoring (SLT) hours available for students to use for every subject. Please see the BTHS site for tutoring schedule.
8. BTHS students will continue the CDC 6 ft rule.
9. Attendance issues can be rectified via contacting via email Ms. Cuesta first and Mr. Newman second.
10. Any issue with teacher's policy that conflicts with the principal should be contest with the teachers, and/or Assistant Principal (AP teachers)
11. 90% of sophomores were given their major first choice.
12. Any summer school will be held virtual unless stated.

Ms. Nottingham (AP Math & Parent and Student Engagement):

1. Students with Club credit issues should contact Ms Nottingham.
2. Only AP algebra 1 is offered to freshmen.
3. Senior dues are in process for students and due limit staff only 300 a week are processed.
4. PSAL is only available based on the coaches and there are no in school training.
5. Sports tryout information will be sent to all students (remote or in school learning) and parents this week. Students are allowed to try out for one sport due to restrictions.
6. There will be graduation on 6/23 at Arthur Ashe Stadium. All information will be sent out soon.
