



#### **Grade Change**



Parents/guardians have the option to request a change of grade to a CR

(credit). A grade of "CR" is a passing grade that holds no weight on a student's grade point average. Thus, a "CR" grade request is for courses in which a student passed with a 65 or higher. This is to process grade requests for the Fall 2020 term ONLY

requests for the ratt 2020 term offer.

You must submit a grade request for each course desired. A separate form must be filled out for each class being changed to "CR" in order to insure proper processing.
